B.I.K.E. -- is it just an acronym in search of a meaning or does it have meaning outside its acronymic existence?

A group bicycle ride started in Venice and proceeded south along the beach bike path to and around the Palos Verdes Peninsula and back. At an overlook of the Long Beach harbor, B.I.K.E. free-associated its way into being. Definitions of the B.I.K.E. acronym vary but B.I.K.E. is not well served in the expenditure of time on definition.

Here are personal remembrances about B.I.K.E.:

"....Maybe B.I.K.E. was formed in each of our respective minds at different times... For me it was sitting at a rest stop by the side of the road on P.V. hill, with a view to the east, just past half way of a ride with Peter, Doug, you, Evan and me. I remember Mo joined us at the bench. Without further research, I can only place it between about 1982 and 1984. I think we collectively, but maybe Peter or Doug in particular, came up with the acronym "B.I.K.E." and then we all tried to figure out what it should stand for. Bicycling Institute of Kinetic Energy was the only (but still lame) title I can remember anybody coming up with. All of those present were deemed charter members and we then loosely discussed bylaws, but the only one that really counted was the "egalitarian" principle that anyone could unilaterally establish or void any rule at any time... ".... I have a clear recollection that on the original Palos Verdes ride, it was Pete, Chris, Evan, me and (maybe) Karl. After some discussion, Bicyclers' Institute of Kinetic Energy (BIKE) was formed at the resting place on the south side of the penninsula, overlooking beautiful San Pedro.... "Doug - 1 July 1998

Born on the wrong side of the tracks in Long Beach, The B.I.K.E. Penny overcame its humble origins and became B.I.K.E.'s shining symbol of good will and fellowship.

Transferred among B.I.K.E. chapters over the years, The B.I.K.E. Penny originated with B.I.K.E. NORTH, moved to B.I.K.E. SOUTH, back to B.I.K.E. NORTH (as pictured here), and now resides with B.I.K.E. NORTHWEST.

On March 21st, 1985 as pictured here, B.I.K.E. SOUTH formally presented The B.I.K.E. Penny to a representative of B.I.K.E. NORTH who had solo bicycled with tremendous effort to the B.I.K.E. The Quarter Step Crank

"...it was a balmy night in the hills above west Los Angeles, yet there was something charged about this atmosphere. Little could I imagine that before the evening ended, I would begin a lifelong friendship with the Erlenmeyer flask, and witness a fundamental paradigm shift in bicycling ergonomics - the quarter step crank......" The development of the quarter step crankset surely represents the pinnacle of B.I.K.E. in the earlier years. Many minutes of fevered technical discussion combined with the considerable man-years of technical expertise within B.I.K.E. led one evening to a serendipitous discovery: *the quarter step crank*! This discovery was so momentous that it should be capitalized to add greater emphasis to this remarkable achievement: The Quarter Step Crank.

B.I.K.E. proved conclusively that it was able to think outside the box and push the envelope of human progress considerably farther than it had dared gone before. 
The Human Toll in the B.I.K.E. Quest for Greatness



B.I.K.E.'s Formative Influences


In pondering the rich stew that is B.I.K.E., several seminal influences stand out over the fundament of group bike
