TOUR HIGHLIGHTS

A personally conducted tour, scenic and educational. Tour starts at Oceanside, California. Finest of the beaches along The Highway to the Stars, past the Sonja Henie Ranch, through the thriving City of Vista, surrounded by its citrus and avocado groves. A visit is made to the Mission San Antonio de Pala on the Pala Indian Reservation. Thence past the Ashley Gem Mines. In these hills is the world's largest deposit of kunzite as well as many other precious stones. We travel on through the beautiful Pauma Valley over the rolling hills to Rincon Springs. We now start the ascent over a fine winding highway to the summit. You will be thrilled by the beauties of the mountain as we pass through towering cedars, spruce, pine, oaks and many other trees before arriving at the Observatory. Your guide then conducts you through the Observatory and explains the workings of the great Telescope. From here we go to the museum to view some of the latest pictures of the sky.

This is the only personally conducted tour to and through the Observatory.

A lunch stop is made at a scenic place on the mountain.

HOW TO GET TO OCEANSIDE "THE GATEWAY TO PALOMAR MOUNTAIN OBSERVATORY
